General Tournament Info

- USAV Rules with exceptions (see attachment)

- · Bring water and nutrition
- Be at court at least 30 minutes prior to match
- ALL players MUST sign release waiver
- There is a Player Pool for athletes seeking a team
- No alcohol consumption by players/team staff while entered in the tournament
- Presiding officials will have final decision on all game related issues
- Athletes are responsible for knowing rules and their exceptions
- Gold, Silver, and Bronze will be awarded

General Tournament Guidelines

- Rules: USAV with modifications (indoor and outdoor)

- Captains MUST report at least 30 minutes prior to match time
- Teams must be ready to take court at respective match time
- Bring drinking water
- No alcohol consumption during splay or playing under the influence
- Minor first aid on site
- Games will be overseen/officiated by certified USAV official(s)
- Additional information will be released closer to tournament time
- o 4 team minimum per format entered by June 1, 2023

6v6 Indoor USAV Rules Exceptions

Rule exceptions are designed to facilitate conducting the volleyball program as smooth as possible. All other rules outlined in the USAV Indoor rulebook remain in effect. Any additional rule exceptions not noted in this guideline that do not give a particular team or individual a distinct advantage

2.1 HEIGHT OF THE NET

2.1.1 Net shall be played at Male/Co-Ed height for 55 years and above age group (7'9 5/8").

4.1 TEAM COMPOSITION

- 4.1.1.b A team may consists of no more than 12 player and 2 coaches/tea personnel.
- 4.1.3.a Final roster must be with presiding officials (R1, R2, scorer) at least 5 minutes prior to the start of match.

4.3 EQUIPMENT

4.3.1 Team apparel need not be identical although it is highly encouraged; however, liberos MUST utilize a highly visible unique identifier. This exception supersedes all other uniform requirements outlined in USAV 4.3.

7.1 THE TOSS

7.1.1 Home team will call the coin toss. Home team will be decided by blind draw prior to the start of the match.

7.2 OFFICIAL WARM-UP SESSION

7.2.1 Duration of warm up will be determined by presiding officials prior to the start of the match with respect to the event timeline. Official warm-up session will be no less than 5 minutes prior to starting the match.

15.6 LIMITATIONS OF SUBSTITUTIONS

15.6.a There will be no limit to the number of substitutions a team can make. It is at the official's discretion to determine if excessive substitutions are impeding gameplay.

18.2 CHANGE OF COURTS

18.2.1 A change of court will be preformed between sets, and at 8 points of any deciding set.



Player Pool Guidelines

The Player Pool is designed to include players from smaller departments and/or players that cannot field a legal team.

1. ELIGIBILITY AND COMPOSITION

- 1.1 Athlete must meet criteria for eligibility in the tournament omnes altiore
- 1.2 Athlete must be employed in a eligible Department of 500 members or less
- 1.3 One (1) Player Pool will exists wherein all eligible athletes are drawn from
- 1.4 Teams seeking an athlete from the Player Pool must :
 - a. five (5) players
 - b. originate from a qualifying department
- 1.5 Teams may be comprised solely of athletes from the Player Pool without limitation to the origin of the athletes making up said team as long as criteria in 1.1.4 are met

2. SELECTION PROCESS

- 2.1 Athletes will be drawn at random to be placed on the next available qualified team
- 2.2 Drawing will be done by blind draw using an objective means of selection, such as using an app, drawing from a hat, or other equitable means
- 2.3 Eligible team requesting athletes from the Player Pool will be placed on an order of merit list (OML). This list shall:
 - a. Be maintained by the program's presiding authority
 - b. Generated by random selection from entire field of Teams requesting athletes
 - c. Subject to final approval by the presiding authority
 - d. Be static whereas teams may not be added to the OML once finalized

3. POST SELECTION TEAM AND ATHLETE CONDUCT

- 3.1 Athletes place on a team must remain on that team for the duration of the tournament
- 3.2 No athlete from the Player Pool may be traded or otherwise play for a team in which it was not initially placed during the selection process

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in The 41st TEXAS FIREFIGHTER SUMMER GAMES (heretofore referred to as "TFFSG") athletic sports program, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

- 1. The risks of injury and illness from the activities involved in this program are significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce these risks, the risks of serious injury and illness do exist; and,
- 2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
- 3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
- 4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND FOREVER HOLD HARMLESS TFFSG committee, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, the host city/cities, venues used, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 5. Further, I grant to the TFFSG Committee and their representative the right to use any photographs, movies, video recordings or other media during the games, practice, or training sessions prior thereto, and,
- 6. To the use of my name and likeness with said material in promotional efforts on behalf of the TFFSG. This constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and is binding and runs the benefit of the heirs, assigns executors and administrators or the parties heretofore. Furthermore, all media shall be the property of the TFFSG and their representative indefinitely and will be released at the discretion of the possessing entity.
